Social Sciences Scholarships for Global Exchange

AIMS

To encourage Social Sciences undergraduate students gaining experience on global exchange at non-local institutions to have a deeper understanding of their professional fields of study, to broaden their horizons and to explore different cultures, the Faculty of Social Sciences is pleased to offer **Social Sciences Scholarships for Global Exchange**. This scholarship is to recognize outstanding social sciences students who participated in the Student Exchange Programme (not as a Major Programme requirement) for one semester or one year.

AWARD

A scholarship at the maximum of HK\$4,000 will be awarded to the outstanding Social Sciences students who participated in the Student Exchange Programme for one semester, or one year in AY2015-16, or in Semester 1 of AY2016-17.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the above scholarship, students are required to meet the following conditions:

- Students who are studying undergraduate programmes offered by the Faculty of Social Science, HKBU;
- With a cumulative GPA score of 3.0 or above;
- Participated in an exchange programme approved by the Department/Programme for study period of one semester to one full year prior to application (excluding the programme-required academic/internship semester); and
- Resumed their studies at HKBU after the exchange

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Shortlisted candidates will be invited to a panel interview
- Judged on basis of written portfolio (60%) submitted upon return from global exchange and panel interview (40%)

The award shall be offered to student with:

- a) An excellent reflective portfolio of the global exchange experience; and
- b) A certain level of academic and non-academic achievement as recognized by the overseas institutions.

(The awarding criteria are subject to review every year)

- i. A completed application form
- ii. A copy of academic transcript
- iii. Any other relevant supporting documents
