

## Global and China Studies Programme Structure

The Four-Year Curriculum is composed of a total of 128 units (see Table 2.1). It includes five components: (A) General Education; (B) Social Sciences Common Core; (C) Global and China Studies Core Courses (see Table 2.2); (D) Global and China Studies Elective Courses (see Table 2.3); and (E) Free Electives.
